Was born in 1951 in Leningrad. In 1970 he graduated from the special music school at the St. Petersburg Conservatory. In 1975 he graduated from the St. Petersburg Conservatory, class of viola (professor Yuri Kramarov).

In 1974-75 he worked with the Mariinsky Theater Orchestra, and since 1975 with the St. Petersburg Philharmonic Orchestra.

Since 1987 he has been working in the chamber ensemble "Soloists of Leningrad" ("Soloists of St. Petersburg"). Took part in numerous tours of the ensemble (USA, Germany, France, Italy, Spain) and in recording music for CDs (all violin and piano concerts by V. Mozart, concerts by A. Vivaldi). Performs a lot in various chamber ensembles, collaborates with the leading soloists of St. Petersburg.

In September 1995 he was invited to the "Modern Trio" ensemble, where he worked until 2000. E. Brodotsky teaches a viola class at the St. Petersburg State Conservatory and at the college named after N.A. Rimsky-Korsakov.
