Over the years professor Rolf Lindblom has moved between various musical genres. From accompanying many of Sweden's leading soloists, to giving his own solo concerts and playing in his own jazz trio.

Rolf Lindblom appears on over thirty CD and LP recordings, both as an accompanist and soloist.

Professor Stina Sundell was Lindbloms teacher during many years. She studied with Emil von Sauer(a Liszt pupil) in Vienna. Lindblom had the favour to study the Liszt pieces with Stina Sundell, recorded on the Liszt CDs(Annees de Pellerinage I, II and soon III) Rolf Lindblom has been teaching as a professor at the Royal College of Music in Stockholm where among other things he taught classical piano improvisation – an old tradition that he has resurrected.

Rolf Lindblom has also made a lot of recitals abroad in Europe: Belgium, Austria, Germany, Czech Republic, Spain, France, Norway, Denmark, Austria and Serbia. Even in USA and Canada.

He is also frequently engaged as a guest teacher at schools and festivals abroad; above all in China, where he also has made recitals. Hohhot(inner Mongolia), Shanghai, Beijing, Hangzhou, Nanjing, Shenzhen, Wuhan and the famous pianoisland Gulangyu.

These days he teaches at Lilla Akademien.
