- Diploma-recipient of international competitions Oleg Sendetskiy was born in Leningrad. In 1980 he graduated from the Rimsky-Korsakov College of Music (class of Professor Emmanuel Fishman), in 1988 he graduated from the Leningrad Conservatory (class of Professor Joseph Levinson). In 1989-1990 he trained in Geneva with Professor François Guy.

In 1984-1986 he was a member of the Klassíka orchestra, in 1987-1999 - in the chamber ensemble "Soloists of St. Petersburg", in 1996-1999 - in the orchestra of the Musorgsky Opera and Ballet Theater (now Mikhailovsky). Since 1999 - principal cellist of the Mariinsky Theater Orchestra.

He gave recitals in Russia, the USA, Japan, Germany, France, participated in the international music festivals Stars of the White Nights, St. Petersburg Musical Spring, From the Avant-Garde to the Present Day.

The musician collaborated with major performers and conductors, including Valery Gergiev, Mark Minkowski, Denis Matsuev, Boris Berezovsky, Pavel Nersesyan, David Geringas. As a member of the Mariinsky Theater Orchestra he took part in the recording of several dozen discs, on the recordings he performed cello solo parts in Shostakovich's First and Fifteenth Symphonies, the symphonic poem Don Quixote by Richard Strauss and other works.

In 2016, Oleg Sendetsky's solo disc with recordings of music by Johannes Brahms was released.
