

SIRKKA KUULA graduated at Sibelius-Academy Helsinki, and gave her debut recitals in Helsinki 1985, London 1989 and New York 1994. Over the years she has performed as a soloist, chamber musician, orchestra and string quartet member in various combinations in Finland and abroad.

Sirkka Kuula works as senior teacher in Espoo music institute. She has been a teacher, a lecturer and a master class teacher for decades, and a senior teacher at the Conservatory of Helsinki 1982-1996.

Sirkka Kuula's double-CD together with pianist Jerzy Gebert was published in 2004. It includes all works for violin and piano from Toivo Kuula (1883-1918), Sirkka Kuula's great-uncle. She has also edited eight publications of Toivo Kuula's string music, they are published by Fennica German.

Sirkka Kuula's violin school "Suomalainen viulukoulu" (Finnish Violin School) was published between 2017-2022. It contains books for violin teaching, playing together and basics for music theory. It is based on the modern understanding of learning and teaching - the music material consists mainly of Finnish folk music.
