He completed the 5th degree of Conservatory of Music in Coimbra in the clarinet class of professor Henrique Pereira. He attended the Percussion Class of the Philharmonic Boa Vontade Lorvanense for 8 years, initially guided by Professor Bruno Amaral and later by Professor João Colaço. He also attended the free percussion course at the Conservatório de Música de Coimbra for 2 years with professor Ismael Silva. In 2016 he started to study Tuba with professor Luís Oliveira, at the Professional School of Arts of Beira Interior.
