Manfred Hubert was born on 11.12.2009 in Bayreuth, Bavaria as part of a musician family. He encountered his first violin lessons at nearly five years old, being taught by Nathan Mendelssohn in Bad Kissingen. By the age of six Manfred played the violin concert by A. Vivaldi a-moll as a soloist with the "Prim Arte" orchestra under Alois Springer and later on J. S. Bach's a-moll composition. Manfred played the great violin concert by F. Mendelssohn -Bartholdy in e-moll- as part of the concert series "Trüdinger-Klangträume" in 2017. In 2019, he reached the first place in the nationwide competition "Jugend musiziert" scoring the highest score possible with F. Mendelssohn's Bartholdy in e-moll. In the same year, the young musician won first place in the Mendelssohn competition in Frankfurt am Main. Since 2013 the family has settled in Hanau. Currently, Manfred visits the Gymnasium "Karl-Rehbein-Schule" in Hanau, the highest level of education for middle schoolers. In his freetime, he enjoys swimming and tennis.
