Dr. Chuanqi Yang, has performed as a soloist, chamber musician and orchestral pianist in different continents. His talent and musicianship have been recognized in many international competitions.

After graduated with the first rank from the Music Middle School Attached to Shanghai Conservatory of Music, he studied with Peter Takacs at Oberlin Conservatory of Music, Kathryn Brown at the Cleveland Institute of Music and Timothy Ehlen at University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana. In his career and artistic development, he is also deeply influenced by Richard Goode, Jean-Yves Thibaudet, Antonio Pompa-Baldi, Alexander Korsantia, Christopher Harding, Susan Starr and Phillip Kawin.

He also serves as a member of the Conservatory Youth Fellowship. His students have won many prizes in national and international competitions.
