

Biography of Halle Naomi Leung

Halle Naomi Leung , American/Hong Konger, was born in Los Angeles, California in 2010, lives in Hong Kong and is studying violin with Hyejin Chung at Takako Nishizaki Violin Studio in Hong Kong for 9.5 years and is awarded the Associate of Trinity College London Violin Diploma in Music Performance. For two summers, she studied at both 31. and 32. Sommermusik Im Oberen Nagoldtal, with Tatiana Liverova, professor in the St. Petersburg Rimsky-Korsakov Conservatory. Halle participated in the Heifetz PEG 2021 summer program taught by Margaret Lysy, music faculty of UCLA, and subsequently became her private student taking regular lessons.

Over the years, she won prizes in a number of violin competitions including **First Place Winner** (Junior Category) of the American Protégé International Piano & Strings Competition 2022 and participated in her school orchestra. She joined the Metropolitan Youth Orchestra of Hong Kong -Senior Orchestra and Haw Par Music and performed with its string orchestra and chamber music groups. Halle believes that sharing music is important and outside of concert settings, she enjoys performing in elderly homes, refugee camps, hospitals and anywhere she can share the joy of music.
