In Victoria, Canada, Matty Angus started learning the clarinet in 2020 at age 11. Since then, he won the Woodwinds Junior Award in 2021 and the Most Outstanding Woodwinds Junior Performance Award at the Greater Victoria Performing Arts Festival (GVPAF) in both 2022 and 2023. In 2022, he also achieved the second place at the Performing Arts of British Columbia Festival (PABCF) and will be once again representing GVPAF this year to compete at 2023 PABCF. In 2022, Matty further represented BC province to compete at the Canada West Performing Arts Festival and won second place in the 17-and-under category. In addition to competing at the provincial festival this year, Matty has also been recommended to compete in the Developing Artists (18 and under) category at the Canadian National Music Festival. In 2022, Matty successfully auditioned for the Greater Victoria Youth Orchestra as one of two clarinetists in the orchestra and, over the past concert season, has enjoyed being a part of all the magical sounds that an orchestra can create.
