

Biography of Cannavale Chiara Maria Beatrice

Born in Naples in March 2004, the saxophonist Cannavale Chiara Maria Beatrice is a versatile musician, active both as a soloist and as a chamber musician, in both classical and contemporary repertoire, and habitually uses all instruments of the saxophone family.

She began studying saxophone at the age of 10 at the IC Tommaso Anardi - music-oriented school in Scafati, and also under the guidance of teacher Vittorio Quinquennale.

Achieved:

- High School Diploma at the Liceo Musicale e Coreutico, Music section Istituto Maresca D., with a grade of 100/100.
- Bachelor saxophone instrument, at the San Pietro a Majella Conservatory of Music in Naples, in the class of teacher Francesco Salime with a grade of 110/110, cum laude and distinction;
- Diplôme d'études musicales COP (Cycle D'Orientation Professionnelle) en saxophone, at the Conservatoire Regional Rayonnement in Versailles (France) in the class of teacher Vincent David with mention très bien.

- Final year of the Master's degree at the San Pietro a Majella Conservatory of Music in Naples, in the class of teacher Francesco Salime.

She has distinguished herself by winning more than 30 national and international competitions both in Italy and abroad.

She has participated as an effective student in numerous masterclasses and stages held by world-renowned concert saxophonists such as: *Claude Delangle; Vincent David, Jean Denis Michat, Nicolas Prost, Christophe Bois, Matthieu Delage, Jerome Laran, Michel Supera; Nacho Gascon; Massimo Mazzoni; Federico Mondelci, Mario Marzi, Marco Gerboni; Marco Vanni; Nikita Zimin, Sergey Kolesov, Mariano Garcia, Christian Wirth*, and others.

She also took part in numerous international saxophone internships such as those of FERMO (Italy), at the XI Edition of the Serino Sax Festival performing in concert as a soloist on 30/12/2020; at the Annual Course with teacher Vincent David held in Rome in 2019, at the VIII and IX International six-month high specialization course "Journey with the saxophone in the classical and contemporary repertoire", performing in the concert of 08/07/2018 and 07/07/2019 at the church of S. Francesco D'Assisi of Campigliano of San Cipriano Picentino (Italy).

His concert activity both as a soloist and in chamber and orchestral music has followed both national and international stages with more than 50 concerts to his credit.
