Eunsong Jung, a <u>21</u>-year-old violinist from Daegu, South Korea, is a talented musician. Her studies are under the guidance of Professor Andreas Röhn, who is a former concertmaster of the Bavarian Radio Symphony Orchestra.

Even in Korea, Eunsong Jung's exceptional talent shone through as she won numerous competitions and auditions. She performed the Sibelius Violin Concerto, Beethoven Violin Concerto, and Wieniawski Violin Concerto No.2 with professional orchestras. This year, she will be performing in Germany, Serbia, and Korea to captivate her audiences.

Apart from her studies, Eunsong Jung is actively involved in various youth orchestras such as the National Youth Orchestra of Germany (Bundesjugendorchester), the NDR Elbphilharmonic Youth Orchestra, and the Albert Schweitzer Youth Orchestra.
