

Martta Kunnola is a 17-year-old violist living in Helsinki. He studies at the Sibelius Academy Junior Academy as a student of Lilli Maijala and Annariina Jokela, and attends second-level studies at the Sibelius High School music department. She started playing the violin at the age of 5. At the age of 12, he transferred to the Helsinki Conservatory as a student of Janne Malmivaara. The main subject changed to viola in the Sibelius Academy's Youth Education in the fall of 2020, where Martta started under the direction of Teemu Kupiainen.

Kunnola has received master course guidance from e.g. Silvia Simionescu, Pisku Ristiluoma, Sirkka-Liisa Kaakinen-Pilch, Anna-Kreetta Gribajcevic and Tommi Aalto, and at Porvoo String Academy. In the summer, he has actively participated in national music courses, e.g. In Nurme, Kälviä, Joutseno, Lapinlahti, Kaarina and Lohja.

Martta has played chamber music in the Junior Academy and Sibelius Academy chamber music groups, at the Stift International Music Festival master class in Holland and in many other student ensembles. He has orchestral experience, e.g. From Sibelius Academy, Helsinki Concordia, Symphony Orchestra. She has worked as a viola player, e.g. with the Helsinki Chamber Orchestra and Uuden Aja Ensemble.

In the fall of 2022, Martta played in the finals of the Oulu National Viola Competition as a soloist of the Oulu Sinfonia, and received the competition's Young Talent award.
