Klára Brabcová

Klára was born 10th of December 2009 in Prague (the Czech Republic).

At the age of 4 years, Klára started playing the piano with Tatiana Babinská. After entering the Music school of Frantisek Antonín Spork in Lysá nad Labem, she represented the school at the piano competition in 2017, where she won 2nd prize in her category. This year she is a piano graduate at this school.

At the age of 6, she added to the piano her dream instrument, the harp, which she began studying with Pavla Jahodová. A year later, Barbora Plachá became her consultant and since 2018 she has been her permanent teacher at the Harp School Arpeggio in Prague. Now she is a student of Prague Secondary School of Music, where she studies a harp at Barbora Plachá class.

Klára has participated in workshops and masterclasses with leading world harpists – e.g. Katerina Englichová, Isabelle Morretti, Veronika Lemishenko or Nicoletta Sanzin.

Klára won several international harp competitions in the Czech Republic, Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary or Argentina. In 2023, she got the 2nd prize in the JS Fest International Competition in Finland and the 1st prize in the Infinity International Music Competition in Hong Kong. In 2024, she got the 3rd prize in the International Harp Competition “Glowing Harp” in Ukraine.

As a young talent, she performed at the Prague Harp Festival or as a musical accompaniment at the presentation of the Medals of the Ministry of Education and Culture in Prague.

She cooperated with the State Opera Prague on the project “Let’s go to the opera! The State opera for children”, where she performed in trio together with viola and flute.
