

Yunxi Peng

He was born in 2000 in Guangzhou, Guangdong, China. His grand father was Peng Jiahuang, a well known composer in the southern part of China. Peng got his first touch with the violin with his father when he was 3 years old, and began his proper study later.

In 2011, he was admitted to the primary school of Xinghai Conservatory. And the next year, he was admitted to the Middle School attached to the Xinghai Conservatory of Music in Guangzhou. Six years later, Peng started his undergraduate study at the Xinghai Conservatory of Music.

While he was in school, he had some private lessons and master classes with Midori Goto, Antje Weithaas, Ian Swensen and Chen Xi who won the Silver Prize at the Twelfth International Tchaikovsky Violin Competition. In 2019, he won the University Scholarship for Professional Excellence. Next year, he was appointed as the Principal of the Symphony Orchestra of Xinghai Conservatory of Music. As a Concert Master, he performed Mahler No. 3, Beethoven No. 3, Brahms No. 3, Bruckner No. 8, Carmina Burana and other symphonies. He performed Mozart's Violin Concerto No. 4 as soloist with the Xinghai Conservatory of Music Symphony Orchestra in November 2021 at Hui Zhou, Canton. In 2022, he was admitted to the Ecole Normale de musique de Paris. In 2023, he was invited to participate in Academy Spring Program on a full scholarship by Irish Chamber Orchestra as well as the Luxembourg Youth Orchestra summer program. In 2024, he was invited to the Luxembourg National Youth Orchestra Spring Program to collaborate with Antje Weithaas on the Brahms Violin Concerto. And he also won a chance to have a masterclass with Antje Weithaas through an audition.

In May 2023, Yunxi passed the entrance exam for the Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel and planned to study both at the Ecole Normale de musique de Paris and Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel.

He is currently studying with Professor Liana Gourdjia and professor Marek Kowalski.
