

How to use the schedule.

Please, find your age group in the main schedule.

Open the appropriate file on the site (one of 3 days), find your name in the the rehearsal block and in the auditions block. There are three possible times for each competitor, acoustic rehearsal, warm up time and competition audition itself.

Acoustic rehearsal is supposed to be located in the competition hall. The rehearsal duration is 5-15 minutes, depending on age group. The precise time is mentioned in the schedule.

This means that you have 5 minutes for trying out the instrument and acoustics.

Warming up in the class. Usually the warm up duration takes the performing time of two previous competitions playing before you. For example:

You have to wait until A. will release the class no.1 to go to audition, then you can warm up while A. and B. are playing at the audition, by the end of B.'s performance you release the classroom for C. and go to the stage.

On the classrooms doors you will see the precise schedule for this classroom. Please, keep to the timetable and warm up only in the classroom scheduled for you. Don't occupy the classrooms scheduled for somebody else even if it appears to be free at the moment. Don't harass other competitors.

It is categorically forbidden to play or tune any instrument in the corridor! You have the classroom, where you can do it just before the stage.
